

2010-2011 Tuition Assistance Program

To be eligible for assistance, a student must demonstrate financial need and have serious interest in Decatur Christian School. To ensure impartiality and sensitivity to privacy, the school employs Confidential Financial Analysis to secure all confidential information. Parents must submit the tuition assistance application form along with the fee to Confidential Financial Analysis. Awarded grants will be applied only to the tuition of the grantee. Every effort will be made to award some financial assistance to all eligible candidates. Students may be eligible for a grant for each of their years at Decatur Christian School. However, the student must apply each year. No awards will be automatically renewed. The tuition assistance program is funded by the Decatur Christian Education Foundation.

- Applications for tuition assistance are available in the school office after January 31, 2010.
- The application for tuition assistance is submitted by the parents/guardians to Confidential Financial Analysis by April 1, 2010.
- Parents of the tuition assistance recipients will be informed no later than May 30, 2010 for the school year 2010-2011.
All are given consideration based on funds available.
- Tuition assistance is always partial.
